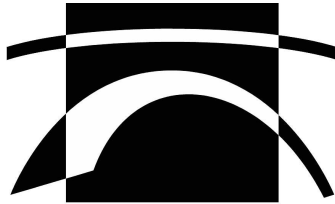

Welcome

This year we are introducing a trimester – system to the Extracurricular Programme at BBIS. It is hoped that dividing up the school year into three terms of roughly the same length will enable students to attend a greater variety of ECAs (extracurricular activities) during the course of the year and avoid them having to miss out on activities that otherwise would have clashed. While every effort is made to allow our students to make both varied and rewarding experiences outside the regular school day it is a general expectation that students attend a selected activity for the entire length of the term.

The term dates are as follows:

- Term 1: September to November (11 weeks)
- Term 2: December to March (14 weeks)
- Term 3: April to June (10 weeks)

Most activities start in the week beginning Monday, September 11th and end in the last week of November. A small number of ECAs, however, deviates from this framework and starts at a later date, or continues into next term. Since ECAs are offered based on student needs some activities may be extended into the second and possibly even third term.

If an activity offered by a member of staff has any cost, the money is used for equipment or supply purchases. You are requested to send any such fees applying to the ECAs your child has selected in a sealed envelop with your child's name and the completed selection form to school. Activities offered by external instructors (names are printed in *italics* on the following pages) may involve fees, which are detailed in this booklet and should be paid to the instructor directly.

Last but not least, I would like to draw your attention to new additions to the ECA programme at BBIS, which were all requested by students and parents alike: Rowing, Ballet, Horse Back Riding, and Karate. These activities are mostly organized in collaboration with local sports clubs or external instructors and hopefully will be well accepted in the BBIS community.
