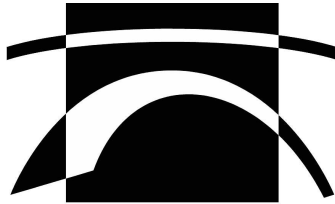

Welcome

Following a very successful first term I am pleased to be able to present the programme of extracurricular activities (ECAs) for the second term. Again, more than 35 ECAs are being offered by teachers and external instructors, providing a great variety of activities for all age groups. It is hoped that these activities will attract many students and that those students who register for an activity will follow through this activity for the entire term.

Term 2 runs from December to March, and most activities start in the week beginning Monday, December 4th. The general term dates are:

- Term 2: December to March (14 weeks)
- Term 3: April to June (10 weeks)

Please note that a small number of ECAs, however, deviates from this framework and starts at a later date, or continues into next term. Since ECAs are offered based on student needs some activities may be extended into the third term.

If an ECA offered by a member of staff has any cost, the money is used for equipment or supply purchases. You are requested to send/bring any such fees applying to the ECAs your child has selected to the relevant teachers after the first session of this activity. Activities offered by external instructors (names are printed in *italics* on the following pages) may involve fees, which are detailed in this booklet and should be paid to the instructor directly.

The tuition fee must be paid in monthly directly to the instrumental teacher due on the first of the calendar month up 'til June.
